

Colby Vredenburg Memorial Scholarship 2026

At least one scholarship will be awarded. Financial support can include tuition and/or expenses such as tools, course registration fees, and required travel for courses or certification. This scholarship offers financial assistance to graduating seniors or high school graduates who are entering school after high school or otherwise pursuing training for a specialized trade such as culinary, carpentry, plumbing, electrical, welding, trucking, or a related apprenticeship.

Scholarship Background:

The Colby Vredenburg Scholarship was established in 2021 to honor the late Colby Vredenburg. Colby was a 1994 graduate of Chariton High School who died on July 25, 2021 after a fiercely fought two-year battle with cancer. Colby lived in Coral Springs, Florida, with his wife of almost 20 years, Nicole, their children Ava and Charles, and their beloved animals, Rosie, Yoshi, and Benny. Colby was an amazing chef and loved cooking both in a commercial kitchen and for family and friends. Colby's other passions were cars, music, traveling, and fishing. When his health no longer allowed him to do those things, he took interest in caring for bonsai. Colby possessed a quiet inner strength and was a calming presence. Colby was a salt-of-the-earth guy, who was comfortable with who he was and with his lot in life. Even in the last two years of his life, he would make the most of his situation and focused on the positives. He cared deeply about his friends and family and showed his love and dedication to them through his actions.

Graduating seniors and high school graduates are eligible for the scholarship. Candidates should submit a completed application packet to the Scholarship Selection Committee by **4 p.m. on Friday, April 10, 2026**. Completed applications should include all the following:
