Mary Sandy Scholarship 2022

The Mary Sandy Scholarship has been established to provide financial assistance to graduating seniors of Chariton High School who will be *pursuing a career in teaching*.

The scholarship was established by Dr. Bill and Pam Sandy, Brock, and Ashton of Holdrege, Nebraska, in honor of his mother's 80th birthday, "to honor her contributions to the education of our family and the members of the surrounding community." Bill and Pam Sandy are graduates of Russell High School; Mary is a graduate of Chariton High School. She attended Chariton Junior College during its last year in existence and went on to a 35-year teaching career (including 29 years in Russell) before retiring.

Two scholarships, in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) each, will be awarded.

Application Process and Eligibility:

Eligible applicants will be graduating seniors of Chariton High School. Candidates should submit a completed application packet to the Scholarship Selection Committee by **5 p.m. on Friday, April 15, 2022**. Completed applications should include all of the following:

The scholarship is a one-time, non-renewable disbursement. The scholarship funds will be sent to the two recipients' educational institution following receipt of written verification of enrollment.
