

Glen L. Mitchell Scholarship 2026

The Glen L. Mitchell Scholarship was established by a bequest from the estate of Glen L. Mitchell in memory of his grandparents, Clinton and Agnes Ambelang Mitchell; his father, Glen L. Mitchell; and his uncle, Richard Mitchell. This scholarship offers financial assistance to graduates of Chariton High School who plan to further their education in an agriculture or natural resources field. It shall be used to pay college tuition or other post-high school education expenses. Preference will be given to those who will attend a college or university in Iowa or a bordering state.

At least one scholarship will be offered in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000). Once awarded, the scholarship is renewable for up to a total of four (4) years, upon demonstration of satisfactory progress toward a degree. Applicants are to be graduating seniors or previous graduates of Chariton High School. Preference will be given to incoming freshmen, although current college students in an agriculture or natural resources field may apply.

Scholarship Background:

Glen L. Mitchell grew up in Waterloo but spent his summer months with his Grandma and Grandpa Mitchell on their farm in Elma, Iowa. Glen enjoyed helping his grandparents and his uncle Richard Mitchell do farm chores and field work. In adulthood, Glen purchased 30 acres in Lucas County and slowly grew his farm. Glen was not afraid of hard work and was frugal with his money. He enjoyed baby spring calves, refurbishing old tractors, and all of nature's beauty. Glen passed away in 2000 after a short battle with cancer. He was passionate about creating a scholarship for students to further their education in animal husbandry, agronomy, or other farm or farm-related pursuits.

Application Process and Eligibility:

Candidates should submit a completed application packet to the Scholarship Selection Committee by **4 p.m. on Friday April 10, 2026**. Completed applications should include all of the following:

- ___ Application form
- ___ List of community involvement/leadership positions
- ___ Three completed reference forms (using the attached form)
- ___ Essay—typed, double-spaced, and 500 words or fewer (See application.)
- ___ Copy of current high school or college transcript
- ___ Current photograph of applicant

The scholarship funds will be sent to the recipient's educational institution following receipt of written verification of enrollment. Recipient(s) must keep the Scholarship Selection Committee informed of any changes in educational plans.
