Dorothy Disney Miller Scholarship 2023

This scholarship offers financial assistance to a graduate or graduates of Chariton High School who rank in the top one-half of their class but may be overlooked for other scholarship awards. It shall be used to pay tuition, room and board, or other expenses of an education at any accredited community college, college, or university.

At least one scholarship will be awarded in the amount of three thousand dollars (\$3,000). Once awarded, the scholarship is renewable for up to a total of four (4) years, upon demonstration of satisfactory progress toward a degree. Once a diploma is achieved, the scholarship will end. Applicants are to be graduating seniors of Chariton High School. The scholarship winner(s) will be announced after May 31, 2023.

Scholarship Background:

The Dorothy Disney Miller Scholarship was established through a bequest from the estate of the late Dorothy Disney Miller. Dorothy Disney Miller was born in Keota Iowa. Dorothy went to school in West Chester, Iowa and graduated in 1926. Dorothy was a victim of Polio and wore a leg brace all of her adult life. She attended Iowa State Teachers College (now known as The University of Northern Iowa) and received her teaching certificate. She moved to Chariton in 1953 and worked in the accounting department of Hy-Vee for 35 years. She retired from Hy-Vee in 1988 at the age of 80. In her pastime she enjoyed embroidering, quilting, and was known for her large collection of hand-made dolls.

Dorothy died at the age of 97. She had a great love for children and animals. It was her wish to establish a scholarship for graduating seniors in Lucas County to help further their education and make a difference in the world.
